OLD BUSINESS

Northwest Lowline Classic

The judge for the show is Rolly Bateman from Saskatchewan, Canada. He has been hired to be the judge for the whole Fair. Jacqui was going to offer \$350.00 to the fair to help cover his expenses. Sponsors are needed for the classes. The amounts are \$100/\$75/\$50 again. The host hotel is the Quality Inn. The Member's Reception will also be held at the Quality Inn. Jacqui is still working with the hotel on the food that will be served for it. We will have a bigger room than last year.

Bill Bartolac would like us to consider making the Lowlife Classic a Fitted show. The Board voted and the decision was unanimous to keep the show as is.

The table for WSLA information was discussed and Katherine and Kai were going to look into prices for banners and other forms of advertising. Selling hats and t-shirts were a couple ideas brought up. The tablecloth will be ready for the show. We are planning on a TV screen playing information on Lowlines as well. We also discussed having folders available at the reception for people who would like more information on the breed. There could also be a

raffle at the show for people who have Lowlines and are interested in WSLA who would leave their contact information.

NEW BUSINESS

The Board feels that we should start using WSLA money to promote membership. We need to find avenues that will reach out and encourage people to join.

The Board also discussed looking for events to sponsor such as WSU's Beef 300 class or the Beef conference in Yakima to help educate and increase awareness of the Lowline Breed.
