## **Treasurer's Report**

There is a balance of \$5748.43 in the account. There were a couple of additional checks written at the show including the judge for \$350 and reimbursing Shelley for copies of the show program for \$48.73 that are not included in the balance.

## **Entry Fee Refunds/Premiums**

To make sure the show premiums and expenses were going to be covered, the board raised the entry fee from \$20 to \$30. Final numbers for the show will be determined and reported on at the next meeting.
